



Special Resolution 2025 VOTING FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

QUESTIONS

Q1. Who is eligible to vote in the Lake View Credit Union director election?

ANSWERS

- A1. All members (except junior members) of Lake View Credit Union in *good standing* are eligible to vote. Good standing is defined in the rules as a member who:
 - (a) has purchased, paid for and holds the number of Class "A" Membership Equity Shares required by the Rules;
 - (b) is not delinquent in any obligation to the credit union
- Q3. How old do you need to be to vote?
- Q4. Who is *not* eligible to vote?
- Q5. How many votes can I have?
- Q6. What if I have more than one account? A6.
- Q7. What if I have a joint account?
- Q8. Can my business vote?

- A3. Nineteen (19) years or older. No junior members are able to vote.
- A4. Unincorporated organizations or societies and/or members under 19 years old.
- A5. Each member gets ONE vote. One member, One vote
 - . Voting is based on membership. One member, one vote, regardless of how many accounts you have.
- A7. Voting eligibility is based on Equity Share accounts – every member has their own individual equity share account.
- A8. Incorporated or limited companies are eligible to vote by proxy of a nonmember which preserves the one member, one vote rule.

Voting by proxy means that you appoint someone you trust to vote on your behalf.

Proxy must be received ten (10) days prior to the election start in order for the business to cast a ballot/vote. If you receive questions about this from a member, please contact Selina

Q9. How do I cast my vote?
 A9. Members cast their vote electronically via our website and MemberDirect. Those that do not have electronic means can visit one of our branches and cast their vote or by ballot at the AGM

- Q11. When does voting occur? A11. The voting period is from March 10 March 14th, 2025, and April 15,2025

Electronic voting is available 24 hours/day through the website or in person ballots can be cast at the AGM
