



### DIRECTOR ELECTION 2025 VOTING FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### QUESTIONS

Q1. Who is eligible to vote in the Lake View Credit Union director election?

## Q2. How long do you need to be a member before you can vote?

- Q4. Who is *not* eligible to vote?
- Q5. How many votes can I have?

#### **ANSWERS**

- A1. All members (except junior members) of Lake View Credit Union in *good standing* are eligible to vote. Good standing is defined in the rules as a member who:
  - (a) has purchased, paid for and holds the number of Class "A" Membership Equity Shares required by the Rules;
  - (b) is not delinquent in any obligation to the credit union
- A2. You must have been a member for at least 120 days prior to the election
- A3. Nineteen (19) years or older. No junior members are able to vote.
- A4. Unincorporated organizations or societies and/or members under 19 years old.
- A5. Each member gets ONE vote. One member, One vote
  - Voting is based on membership. One member, one vote, regardless of how many accounts you have.
- A7. Voting eligibility is based on Equity Share accounts – every member has their own individual equity share account.

Q8.	Can my business vote?	A8.	Incorporated or limited companies are eligible to vote by proxy of a non- member which preserves the one member, one vote rule. <b>Voting by proxy</b> means that you appoint someone you trust to <b>vote</b> on your behalf.
			Proxy must be received ten (10) days prior to the election start in order for the business to cast a vote. If you receive questions about this from a member, please contact Selina Lajeunesse
Q9.	How do I cast my vote?	A9.	Members cast their vote electronically via our website and MemberDirect. Those that do not have electronic means can visit one of our branches.
Q10.	Where does voting occur?	A10.	Electronic Voting will be located on our website <u>www.lakeviewcreditunion.com</u> on the home page and in branch. Q11.	When does voting occur?	A11.	The voting period is from March 10 - March 14 <sup>th</sup> , 2025
